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Goldgeier is the author of *Leadership Style and Soviet Foreign Policy* (John Hopkins, 1994), which received the Edgar Furniss book award in national and international security, and *Not Whether But When: The U.S. Decision to Enlarge NATO* (Brookings, 1999). He co-authored (with Michael McFaul) *Power and Purpose: U.S. Policy toward Russia after the Cold War* (Brookings, 2003), which received the 2004 Leggold Prize for the best book on international relations. His most recent book (co-authored with Derek Chollet) is *America Between the Wars: From 11/9 to 9/11* (PublicAffairs 2008), named a best book of 2008 by Slate.
