

Anne Deighton is Professor of European International Politics at the University of Oxford. She teaches and works on European security in a contemporary and historical context, and on British foreign policy. She is currently working on Ernest Bevin, British foreign secretary, 1945-51; on Britain and the emergence of a postwar human rights regime; and on issues relating to the broadening of 'human' security. She is a Jean Monnet ad personam professor in the history of European integration, and is on the academic steering committee of the EU Framework 6 GARNET network: 'Global Governance and the EU'. She has been a professeur invité at the Institut Universitaire de Hautes Etudes internationales, Geneva, and also a faculty fellow in the Geneva Centre for Security Policy. She has been a professeur invité at Paris I, Paris III, and Université Libre de Bruxelles. She is a member of the Royal Institute of International Affairs, (Chatham House), London, and has served on its Council and Executive.
