Dr. Wolfgang Krieger is University Professor of Modern History and History of International Relations at Universität Marburg / Germany. He held fellowships at St Antony's College Oxford and at Harvard University and has taught at Universität München, Johns Hopkins University (Bologna), Princeton University, University of Toronto, and Institut d'Études Politiques ("Sciences Po") / Paris. He has published widely on the history of the cold war, on European-American relations after 1945, on German and British foreign policy, on military history as well as on the history and politics of secret intelligence services. His most recent book is a history of intelligence from Ancient Egypt to the present (in German), forthcoming from C.H. Beck Verlag, München.
